Camping Gear

- Tent with stakes

- Sleeping bag/cot/air mattress (battery pumps only)
- Blanket/pillow
- Lantern or light for inside tent
- Extra blanket (for cold nights)

Safety & Tools

- Small shovel (for fire, tent setup, etc.)
- Knife
- Duct tape
- Ax/hatchet or hammer
- Compass (for workshop)
- Old shoelace (for workshop)
- Bug spray and sunscreen
- Flashlight/headlamp
- ****Optional:**** Bright/reflective vest

Food & Cooking

- Food needing only hot water
- 1-gallon minimum drinking/cooking water
- Cutlery/knife
- Bowl/plate
- Cooking pot or bowl
- Lighter/matches or fire starter
- Washing water for pots, hands, and brushing teeth (1-gallon minimum)
- Water bottle or Camelbak
- Camp meals (Mountain House meals, MRE, etc.)
- Instant ramen/CupOnoodle
- Bisquick shake 'n pour pancakes
- Hot dogs/sausages/bacon
- Veggies for roasting
- Jerky or freeze-dried foods

- Powdered Gatorade or drink mixes
- Non-electric coffee pot/instant coffee
- Snacks and treats
- **Optional:** Camping stove with gas

Personal Items

- Boots/rugged shoes
- Hoodie and/or jacket
- Poncho/umbrella
- Extra clothes (especially socks & underwear)
- Toiletries (toilet paper, shampoo, conditioner, soap, lotion, toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, etc.)
- Medications
- 2 waterproof bags for garbage/laundry
- Camo/dark clothes for laser tag
- Towel
- **Optional:** Board games
- **Optional:** Musical instruments (moisture-conscious)

Optional Extras

- Extra batteries
- Extra camping stove fuel
- Extra string or paracord
- First aid kit
- Walkie-talkie
- Battery-powered speakers
- Gloves
- Binoculars
