Children ages one-year through five-years old are then welcomed and encouraged to participate in an age-appropriate setting. They are introduced to the Word of God, prayer and worship in a nurturing and loving atmosphere.

Get ready, get set, GO! Children in grades kindergarten through fourth grade will experience an afternoon of worship, games and enjoy a snack together.

SPARK aligns lessons with OCGF's Monthly Themes. We encourage children to learn memory verses and participate in interactive story telling.

SPARK is available during the second service which begins at 11:15 AM. Children participate in praise and worship with their parents and then should be escorted to the Check-In Kiosk located in the Youth/Arts Wing.

IGNITE PRE-TEEN MINISTRIES! Children in grades 5th through 7th participate in the Main Sanctuary Worship Service with their parents at 11:15 AM.

Following the Worship Service, they will be received by Ignite leaders in the Youth/Arts Wing and welcomed by enthusiastic, relevant teaching that point them to the Lord. It's an hour of exciting instruction in the ways of the Lord.

IGNITE strives to point children to experience and serve God. The ROAD continues to Breakout! Youth Ministry (ages 13-18) and finally crossing over to Breached Young Adult Ministry (ages 18-35).






